# *Save Our Hospitals!*

- Ealing and other towns are in a local and national A&E crisis. Patients are lying in ambulances for hours because there are no beds for them.
- Even the British Red Cross recently stated that Britain was facing a “humanitarian disaster.”
- Managers at Ealing and Northwick Park Hospitals recently instructed staff to send patients home early to make room for more!
- Amazingly, Ealing Clinical Commissioning Group is STILL preparing to close Ealing A&E and hundreds of beds in the hospital. Our local hospital would end up as a series of clinics, an urgent care centre and a few dozen beds.
- Under the North West London “*Sustainability and Transformation Plan*” hospital beds are to be replaced with so-called “Out Of Hospital” services. But there are no significant “replacement” out of hospital services and our GPs are overloaded already. We say it’s time to stop cutting and privatising our NHS.
