WE NEED OUR HOSPITALS

- NHS cuts have created a local and national A&E crisis. Millions of patients are suffering the longest ever waits for both urgent and “non-urgent” treatment. Patients are lying in ambulances for hours because there are no beds for them.
- Managers at Ealing and Northwick Park Hospitals recently instructed staff to send patients home early to make room for more!
- But Government cuts are continuing on a savage scale and there will actually be a reduction in spending per head next year. Already we are way behind other European countries in health spending and beds per head.
- And here in Ealing the health bosses are STILL preparing to close Ealing A&E and hundreds of beds in the hospital.
- The “Sustainability and Transformation Plan” for North West London hospital includes cutting 7,750 NHS jobs, closing 600 hospital beds, cutting A&E visits by 64,000, hospital admissions by nearly 50,000 and outpatients appointments by nearly ¼ million!
- We NEED our hospitals. The STP is immoral - it must be scrapped.
